

Our Market

The BankUnited Center is located on the campus of the University of Miami in Coral Gables, FL, which is 5 miles southwest of Downtown Miami. In the past three decades, the city, known as "The City Beautiful" has experienced healthy growth, which has bolstered the economic base. Today, Coral Gables is home to approximately 155 multinationals and 22 consulates and trade offices. It is also known as the "Fine Dining Capital of South Florida" and has the highest concentration of live theater in Miami-Dade County. Growth in the commercial sector has brought a wealth of new activities for residents, including nighttime entertainment, live music, casual and fine dining, and new retail options.

Miami-Dade County, in which Coral Gables is located, is the most populous county in the state of Florida and the eighth most populous county in the United States.

The BankUnited Center (BUC) is a 200,000 square foot, 8,000+ seat multipurpose entertainment facility managed by Global Spectrum located in the heart of beautiful Coral Gables, Florida on the University of Miami Campus. Opening its doors in January 2003, the event represented the first time a mid-size venue had opened south of downtown in Miami-Dade County. Currently, the BUC remains the largest facility of its kind south of Downtown Miami.




Location/Transportation:
